## **Class 1: SLB Supplies Pairs Hunter Trial**

This BOGEY TIME class will be run over a course of approximately 24 fences, height approximately 2ft9in to 3ft3in. It is intended to cater for novice horses/ponies that require cross-country experience.

Fence numbers RED on WHITE

Riders to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday

Entry Fee: £51.25 per pair including MFHA levy and contribution to medical services

Prizes for first placed pair and rosettes to 4<sup>th</sup> place

## **Class 2: The McDonalds Restaurant Cubhunters Novice Class**

(Teams of 4, with minimum of 3)

This class will be run over a course of approximately 24 fences, height approximately 2ft9in to 3ft3in. It is intended to cater for novice horses/ponies that require cross-country experience.

### **Section A:** This will be a BOGEY TIME class

Riders to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday

The Ann Prosser Perpetual Cup, kindly donated by Mrs. A. Prosser to the winning team, along with prizes kindly provided by Apollo Saddlery

Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place

### **Section B:** This will be a SPEED class against the clock

Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £100 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize £60 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize £40

Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place

Entry Fee of Both Selection of Class 2: £101.50 per team including MFHA levy and contribution to medical services.

## **Class 3: The Howkins and Harrison Open Foxhunter Class incorporating the Skinner's Pet Food National Open Qualifier**

(Teams of 4, with a minimum of 3)

The Open Class is a qualifier for National Championships to be held in Spring 2018 and will be run over a course of approximately 27 fences.

Fence numbers Black on White

Entry Fee: £141.50 per team including MFHA levy and contribution to medical services

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £400 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize £240 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize £120 – 4<sup>th</sup> Prize £80  
Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> Place

## **Class 4: "Café 1804" at Bosworth Marina Sportsman Intermediate Class**

(Teams of 4, with a minimum of 3)

The Intermediate Class will be run over a course of approximately 25 fences with no fixed fence exceeding 3ft6.

Entry Fee: £121.50 per team including MFHA levy and contribution to medical services.

The Lampard Perpetual Cup, kindly donated by R.J. Lampard to the winning team.

Special Prize: for the competitor completing the course in the fastest individual time

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £180 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize £120 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize £60  
Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> Place

### **Prize Giving:**

Class 1 + 2 (A+B): at the end of class 2

Class 3 + 4: at the end of class 4

A representative must be present, otherwise prize money/prize may be forfeit.

**Would all competitors please take note that this year, there will be a pen in classes 2, 3 and 4.**

### **Entries:**

(All entries include a non-refundable booking fee per class whether it is online or postal entry, included in the above fee). All competitors must have their own personal insurance. Crash helmets and body protectors will be checked to ensure they comply with the standard requirements set by the MFHA. All hats must be colour-tagged prior to use and tags are available in secretary's tent on the day of the event at £2.00 each. For

£10.00 deposit for bibs is required on the day.

1. Entries can only be accepted if they are submitted with the correct Entry Fee.
2. Unless Fees are received in full competitors will not be permitted to take part.
3. Any Competitor jumping a fence (other than the practice fence) prior to the competition will be disqualified.
4. The organisers reserve the right to return or refuse any entry.
5. The organisers and the landowners do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any person or property whatever on the ground. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. No responsibility can be accepted for damage to or loss from those vehicles moving or parking on the premises.
6. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
7. Number cloths should be collected from the secretary's tend. Team classes please ensure that each rider wears the correct colour and notify the Secretary of any changes to the original entry. A refundable deposit of £10 per team will be required.
8. Competitors shall report to the Collecting Ring Steward 15 minutes before their start time. Any team not running in programme order will be penalised by a 30 second penalty.
9. Exchanging horses is not allowed after a competitor has started.
10. The organisers reserve the right to: Withhold any prizes because of insufficient declared entries alter the advertised times Eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules.
11. In the event of a dispute the Steward's decision is final. Any competitor wishing to lodge an objection must first deposit £40 with the Secretary and make their objection in writing. If upheld the deposit will be refunded.
12. In the event of a postponement due to any unforeseen circumstances no refund of entry fees can be made. In the event of cancellation 50% of entry fees will be returned.
13. Veterinary surgeons & farriers will be on the field during the competition and competitors will be required to pay for any services received.
